- "Awards For Excellence 2015" is open to all financial members of the MRCAA Ltd
- Companies that are financial members of the MRCAA Ltd are eligible to place multiple entries in all categories.
- Open to projects completed between 1 October 2014 to 30 September 2015.
- All entries to be submitted with an official entry form.
- One project only per entry form but there is no limit to the number of entries you can submit.
- All entries to be accompanied by at least four high resolution (minimum 300dpi and no smaller that A4) photographs, of the project showing the facility and various details such as screw line, ridge and gutter lines, fascia, roof penetrations and details of any difficult work which would represent excellence in workmanship.
