ENTRY GUIDELINES

- All entries must be installed on the Australian mainland (New South Wales, Victoria, Queensland, South Australia, Western Australia, Tasmania, Northern Territory, Australian Capital Territory) or any island or territory that is under administration of the Australian Government).
- All entries are automatically entered into the Rex Blackwell Award.
- "2020 & 2021 Awards For Excellence" is **open to all financial Contractor Members** of the MRCAA.
- Companies that are financial Members of the MRCAA are eligible to place multiple entries in all categories.
- Open to projects completed between 1 October 2019 to 30 September 2021.
- All entries to be submitted with an official Entry Form.
- Any one project is limited to entry into two separate award categories only.
- All entries to be accompanied by **no more than 15** high resolution (minimum 300dpi and no smaller than A4) photographs of the project depicting such details as screw line, ridge and gutter lines, fascia, roof penetrations and any difficult work. Included in the 15 photographs must be 3 of the overall Project.
- Supporting documentation no more than 1 page explaining why the project has merit and should be awarded.
